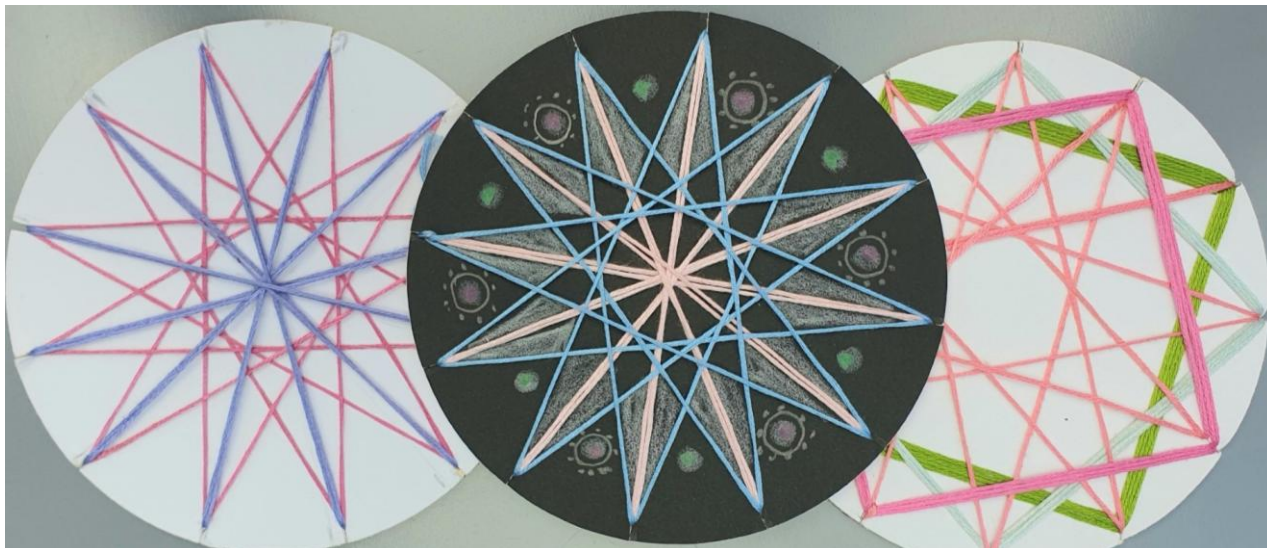


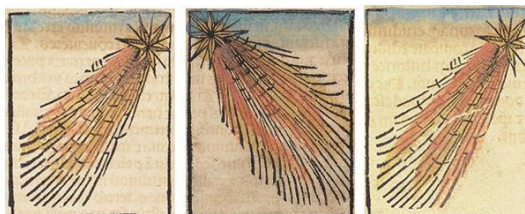
Get all wrapped up this winter with Skippko's *Flowers of the Sky*
